

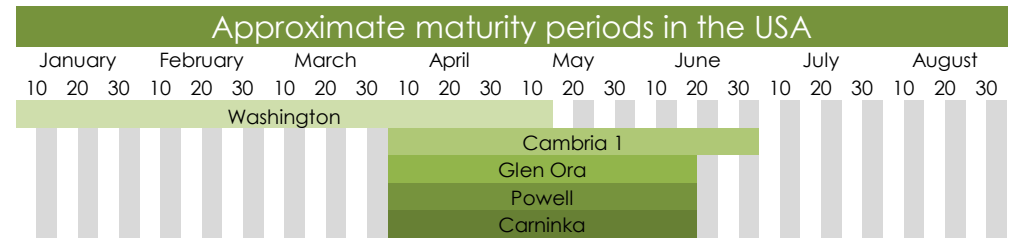
Cambria 1 (Witkrans) Late Navel

Late-maturing navel



- **Parentage:** Natural mutation derived from a Palmer navel tree
- **Status in the USA:** Field evaluations
- **True to type status in USA:** Confirmed
- **Patent status:** Not patented

- **Appearance:** Firm fruit with a smooth rind, and deep orange flesh. The navel end is usually closed, as is the core.
- **Seed:** No seeds
- **Average fruit size:** 70-85 mm
- **Fruit shape:** Round to ovoid
- **Fruit color:** Deep orange rind
- **Horticultural growth habit:** Trees are smaller and more compact than Palmer navel
